

# CFC 渥太华华人高尔夫球公开赛 (2014)

## 方式与规则

赛前务必阅读，确保完全理解所有规则

### 方式

一轮 (18 洞)比杆赛，The Meadows Golf and Country Club, North/South。

### 奖励

1. 渥太华华人高尔夫球公开赛冠军 (2014)
2. 男子前3名
3. 女子前2名
4. 最快进步奖 (不分男女)
5. B组 (第11名)、C组 (第21名) 和D组 (第31名) 优胜奖 (不分男女)
6. 一杆进洞 (不分男女)  
三杆洞之一奖BMW宝马车一辆，其它三杆洞也有不同奖励。
7. 最远距离奖 (男女分设)
8. 最近洞奖 (男女分设)

### 开球台

男子使用白色开球台。

女子与少年 (14岁及以下) 使用红色开球台。

### 比赛速度

- 1、 每轮比赛必须在5小时05分之内打完。不论后组是否紧跟，必须始终与前组保持一杆距离。轮到自己击球时，选手须在30秒内将球击出，果岭上计时从上一位球员的球停止开始。打完18洞如超时，该组所有球员各罚1杆。如因前组慢打造成超时，组委会将遵照OVGA规则按实际用时判定是否罚杆。
- 2、 每洞上限为该洞双倍标准杆，即3杆洞最多打6杆，4杆洞最多打8杆，5杆洞最多打10杆。

### 衣着要求

1. 男子球衫须带领。上衣必须扎进腰带。
2. 女子球衫无袖则带领，无领则带袖。
3. 禁穿牛仔类衣裤。

### 球场维护

请修复打痕，耙平沙坑。

请勿在比赛结束后不交费继续上场打球

### 规则

比赛遵守RCGA规则，但有以下OCGO当地规则：

- 1、 忽略球场记分卡上的当地规则。
- 2、 允许使用 GPS 激光测距仪测距。
- 3、 不允许携带球童及随行观众。
- 4、 可以租用动力车，但应在同组球员视线内找球，并遵守球场球车规则及礼仪。
- 5、 选手必须轮换记分，A 记 B，B 记 C，C 记 D，D 记 A。赛后选手及记分员必须双方在记分卡上签字并上交组委会。
- 6、 果岭上不能免推，球必须进洞。
- 7、 不打暂定球。白桩、黄桩、遗失球及不可打均按红桩处理，即选手接受罚 1 杆，可返回原地重打，也可选择在下文定义的抛球区继续比赛。
- 8、 找球时间为 3 分钟。超过 3 分钟视为遗失球。选手接受罚 1 杆，可返回原地重打，也可选择在下文定义的抛球区继续比赛。
- 9、 球员应标记所有比赛用球，如无法证明找到的球属于自己，按遗失球处理。
- 10、 不得以“练球”名义打球 (包括推球)，违规一次罚 2 杆，一轮最多罚 4 杆。
- 11、 南 9 洞与西 9 洞球道之间沙地不算沙坑。
- 12、 抛球区
  - (1) 球落到界外 (白桩区)、黄桩区、红桩区、遗失或不可打：接受罚 1 杆，在最后进入点两杆身长距离内，且不更靠近球洞处抛球。
  - (2) 球落入沙坑维修部分或沙坑积水，在沙坑内可打区域免罚抛球。也可接受罚 1 杆，在沙坑外且不靠近球洞处抛球。
  - (3) 超出抛球区抛球，初犯罚 2 杆，再犯取消成绩。



# CFC Ottawa Chinese Golf Open (2014)

## Format & Rules

Please read this document in full to ensure all rules are clearly understood.

### Format

One round (18 holes) stroke play at The Meadows Golf and Country Club, North/South.

### Awards

1. OCGO Champion (2014)
2. Men: 1st to 3rd
3. Women: 1st to 2nd
4. Most Improved (M or W)
5. Champions of Group B (11th), C (21st) and D (31st) (M or W)
6. Hole-in-one (M or W)  
One of the par 3 holes is selected for a BMW car. Other par 3 holes are entitled for a prize.
7. Longest Drive (M and W)
8. Closest to Pin (M and W)

### Teeing Ground

Gentlemen will play white tee.

Ladies/juniors (14 and under) will play red tee.

### Pace of Play

1. The round must be played within 5 hours 5 minutes. It does not matter if there is a group behind you or not, you must stay one-stroke-distance behind the group ahead of you at all times. Each person is to execute his shot in 30 seconds from when it becomes his turn. On the putting green the clock starts when the last person's ball stops rolling. If a group completes 18 holes overtime, each player in the group will incur a penalty of one stroke. Provided that the delay is caused by the slowness of previous group, the committee will evaluate the actual time and make final decision based on OVGA rules.
2. Each hole is limited to double par. i.e., 6 strokes maximum for par 3, 8 strokes for par 4 and 10 strokes for par 5.

### Dress code

1. Men's collared shirts. Must be tucked in
2. Women's collared or sleeved shirts
3. No denim

### Rules

Complete RCGA Rules of Golf will be used with exception to the OCGO local rules as follows:

1. Disregard local rules on the course scorecards.
2. Any type of GPS and range finders are permitted for measuring distance.
3. No caddy or following spectator is permitted.
4. Power carts are permitted. However ball should be searched within the sight of other competitors. Please adhere to course rules and etiquette.
5. Score cards must be rotated among players. After competition, score cards must be signed by both play and marker then submitted to the committee.
6. No concession (gimmes). Ball must be holed out.
7. No provisional balls. Any white stake, yellow stake, lost ball and unplayable will be treated as red stake. i.e., players take a penalty of one stroke and may continue to play in the drop area defined below.
8. Finding balls in rough is limited to 3 minutes. After 3 minutes it is deemed a lost ball. Players take a penalty of one stroke and may continue to play in the drop area defined below.
9. Players should mark all golf balls in play. Provided that a ball cannot be proven that it belongs to the player, the ball is deemed as lost.
10. No practice shots including putting are permitted. Each breach incurs a penalty of two strokes. Penalty of four strokes is the maximum in a round.
11. Sandy areas between South 9 and West 9 are not treated as bunkers.
12. Drop Area
  - (1) Ball is out of bound, lost, unplayable, lies in an area defined by yellow stakes or red stakes: take a penalty of one stroke and drop the ball within two club-lengths of and not nearer the point where the ball last crossed the margin of the area.
  - (2) Ball for bunker GUR relief must be dropped in the same bunker. Or under penalty of one stroke, drop the ball out of the bunker, not nearer the hole.
  - (3) Dropping ball in wrong area incurs a penalty of two strokes. Second time breach: disqualification.
